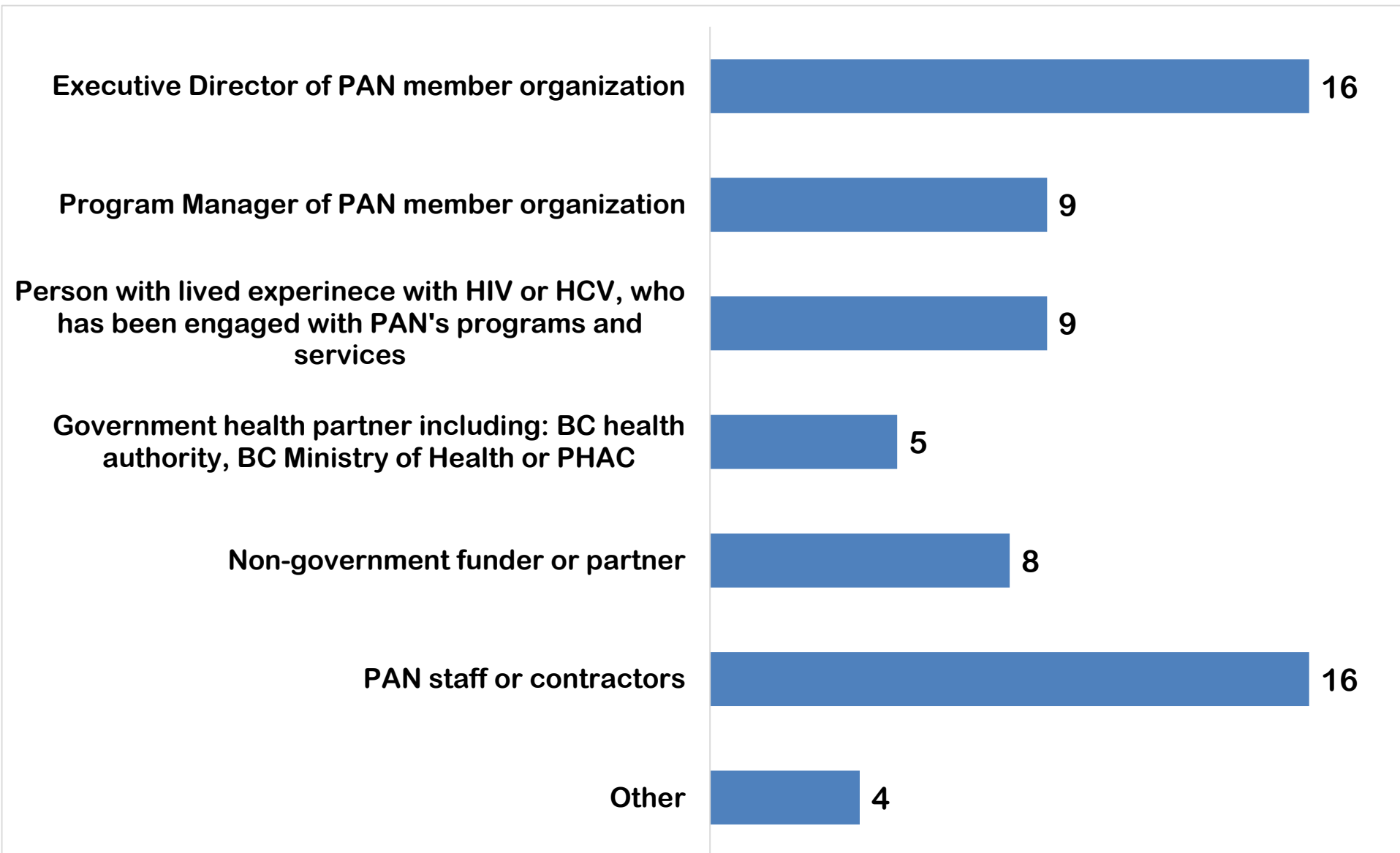

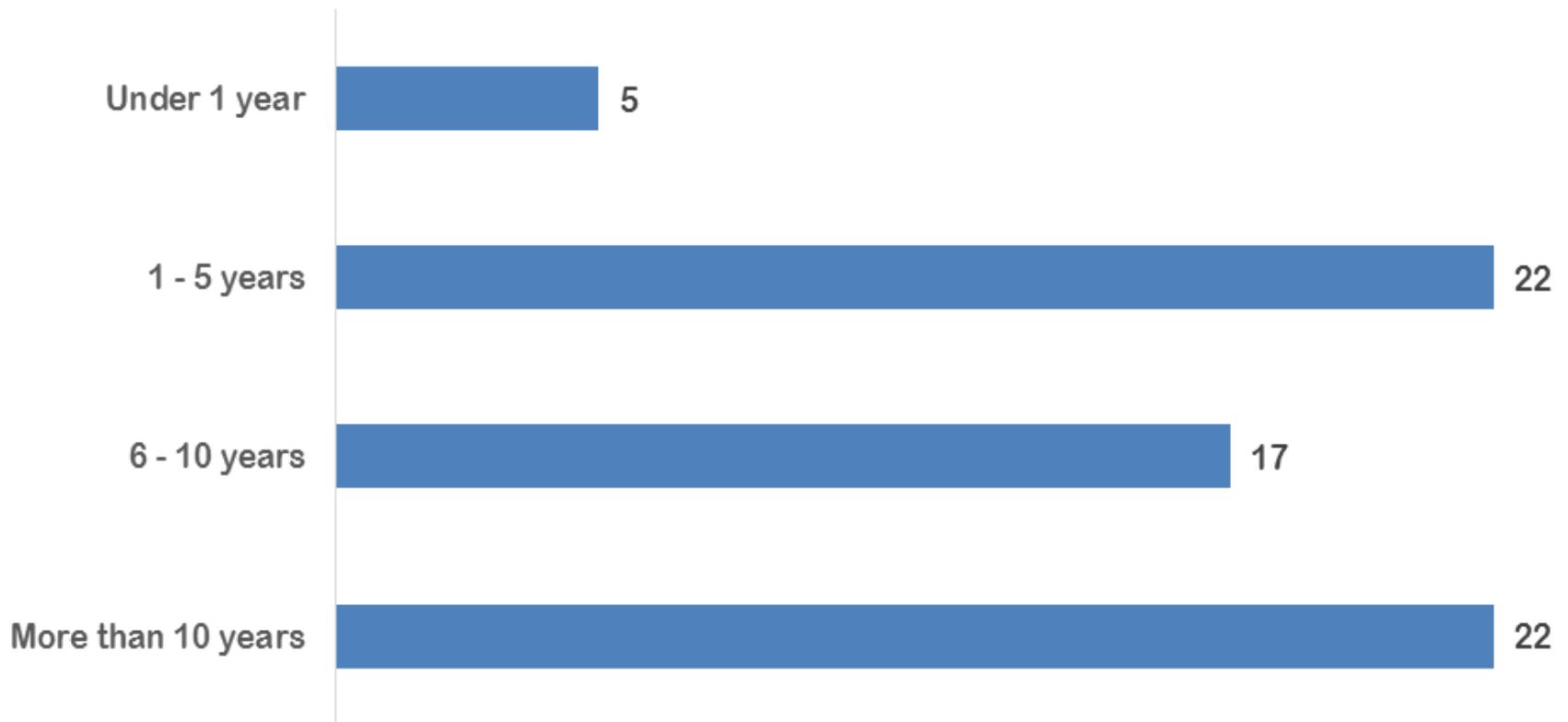

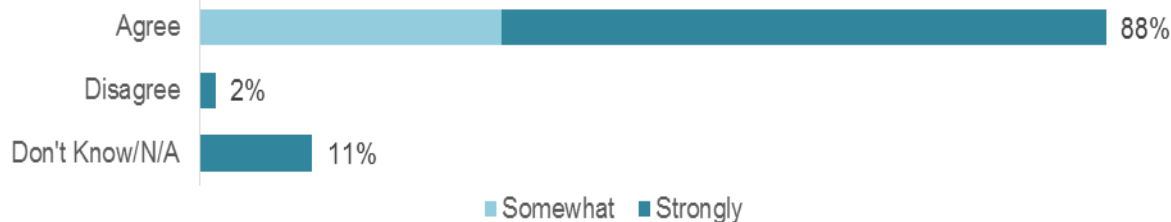

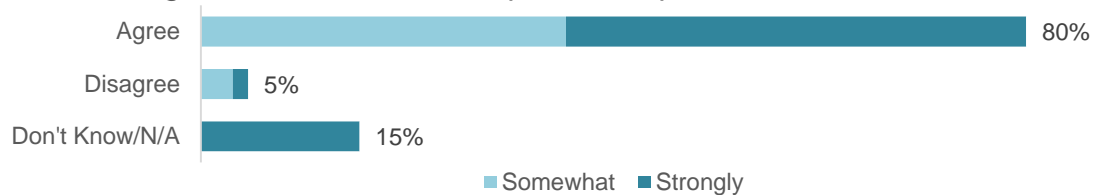

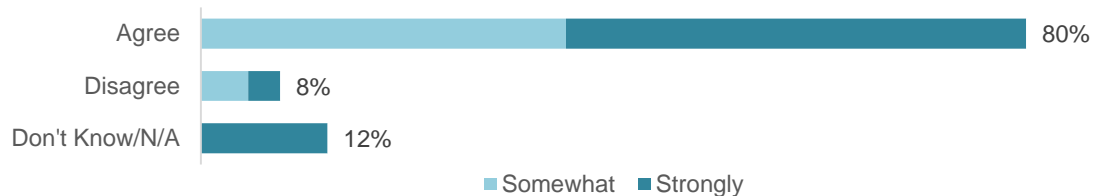

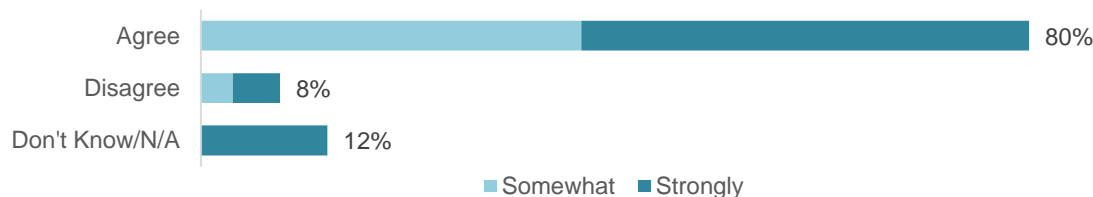

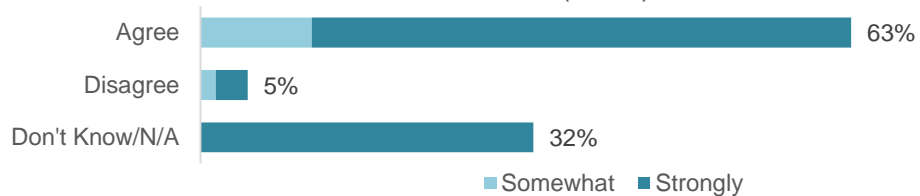

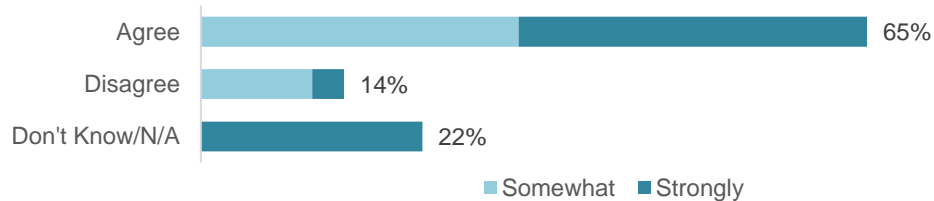

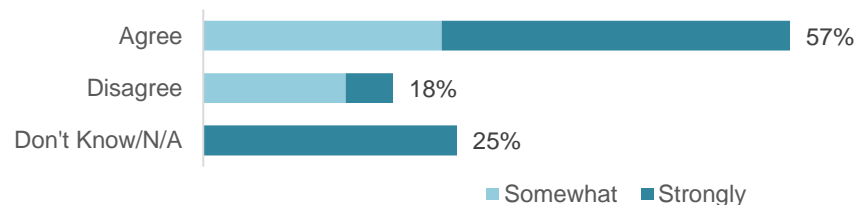

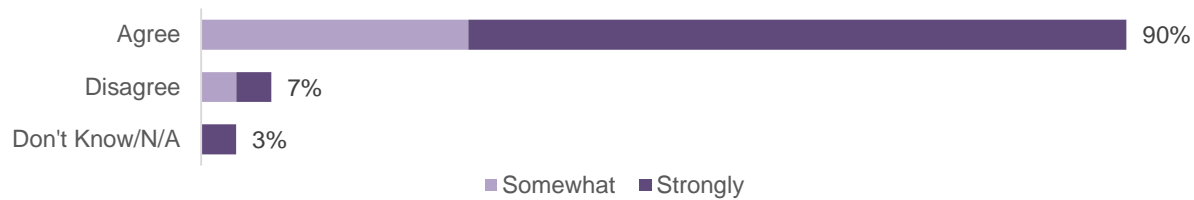

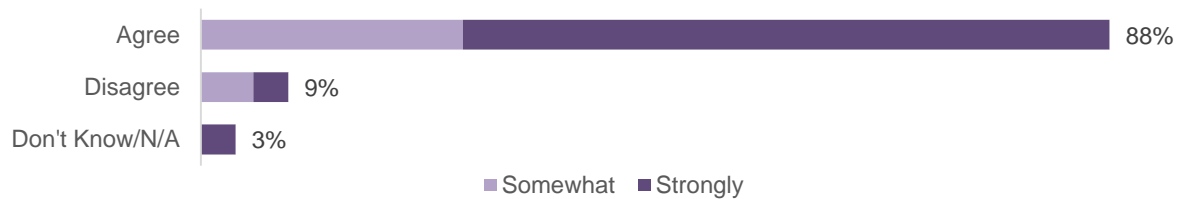

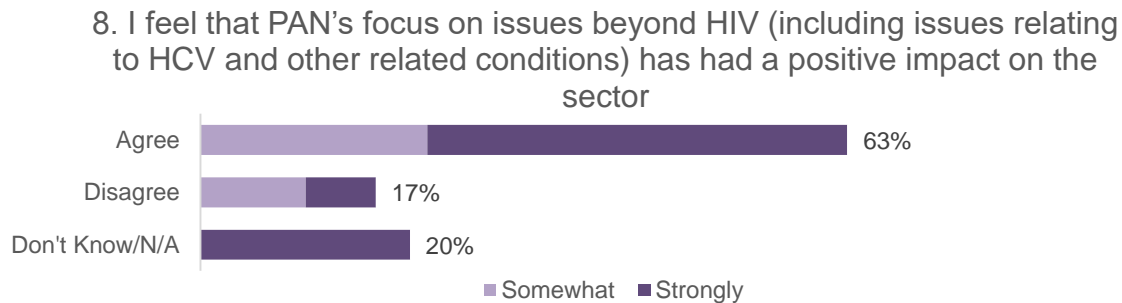

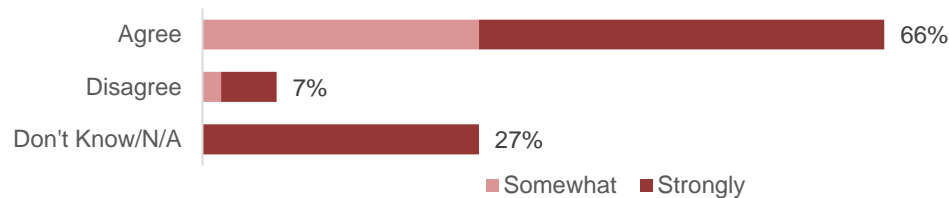

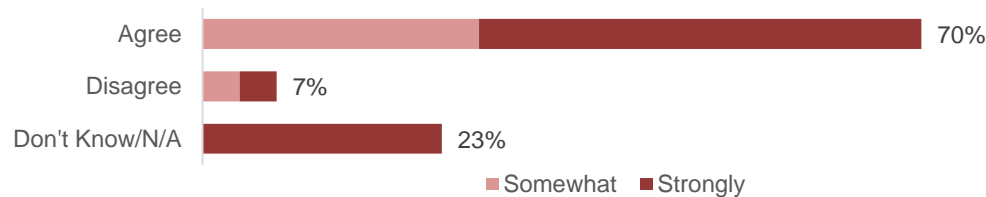

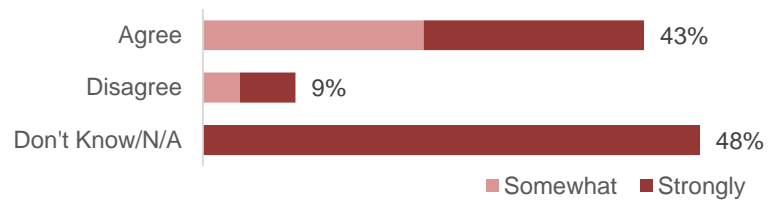

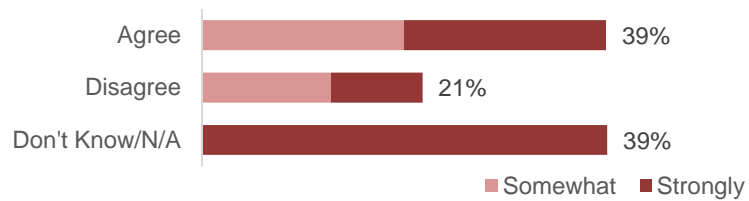

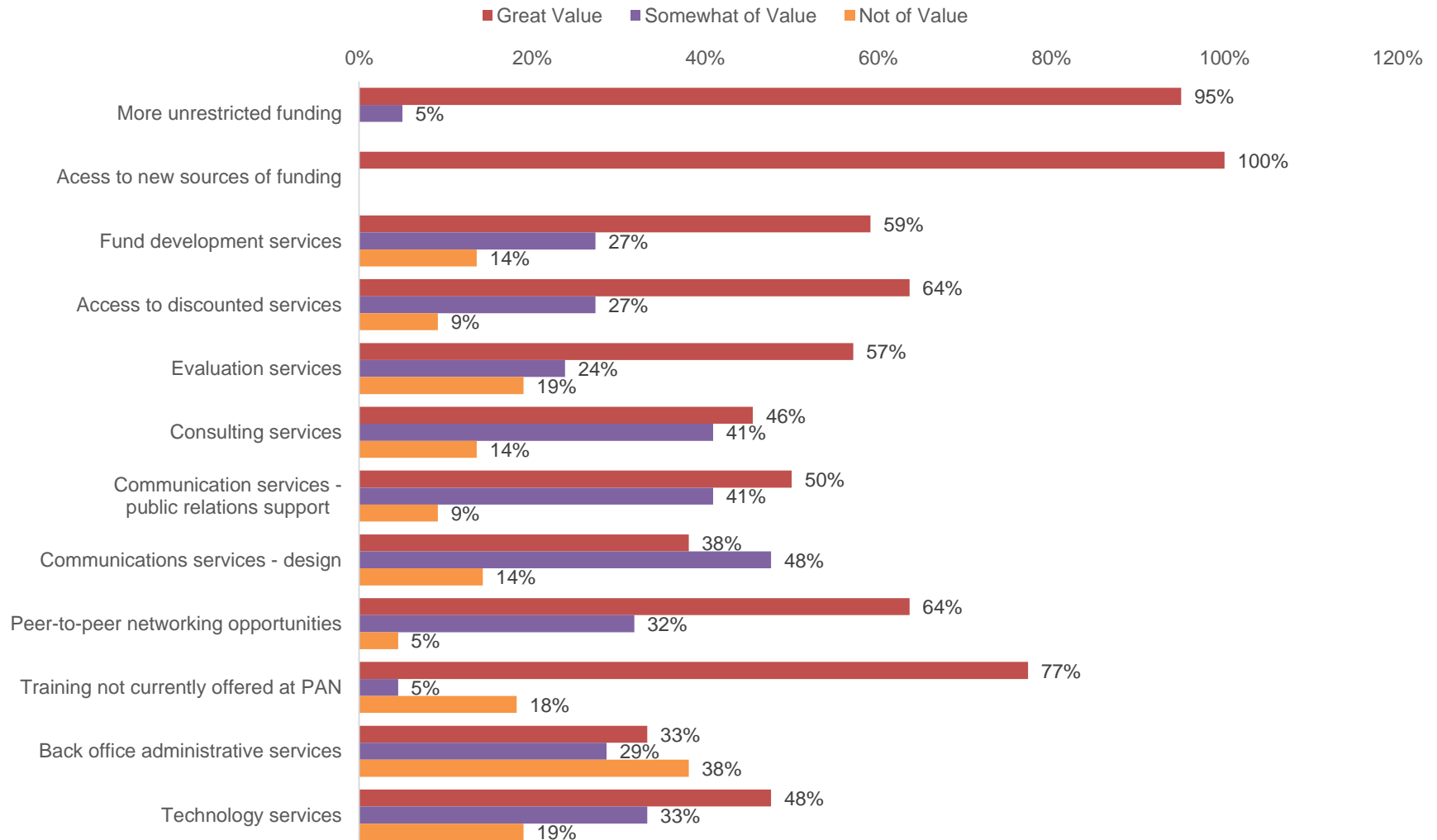


13. Our organization accesses CBR findings and analyses through PAN



Value of potential provincial services/supports

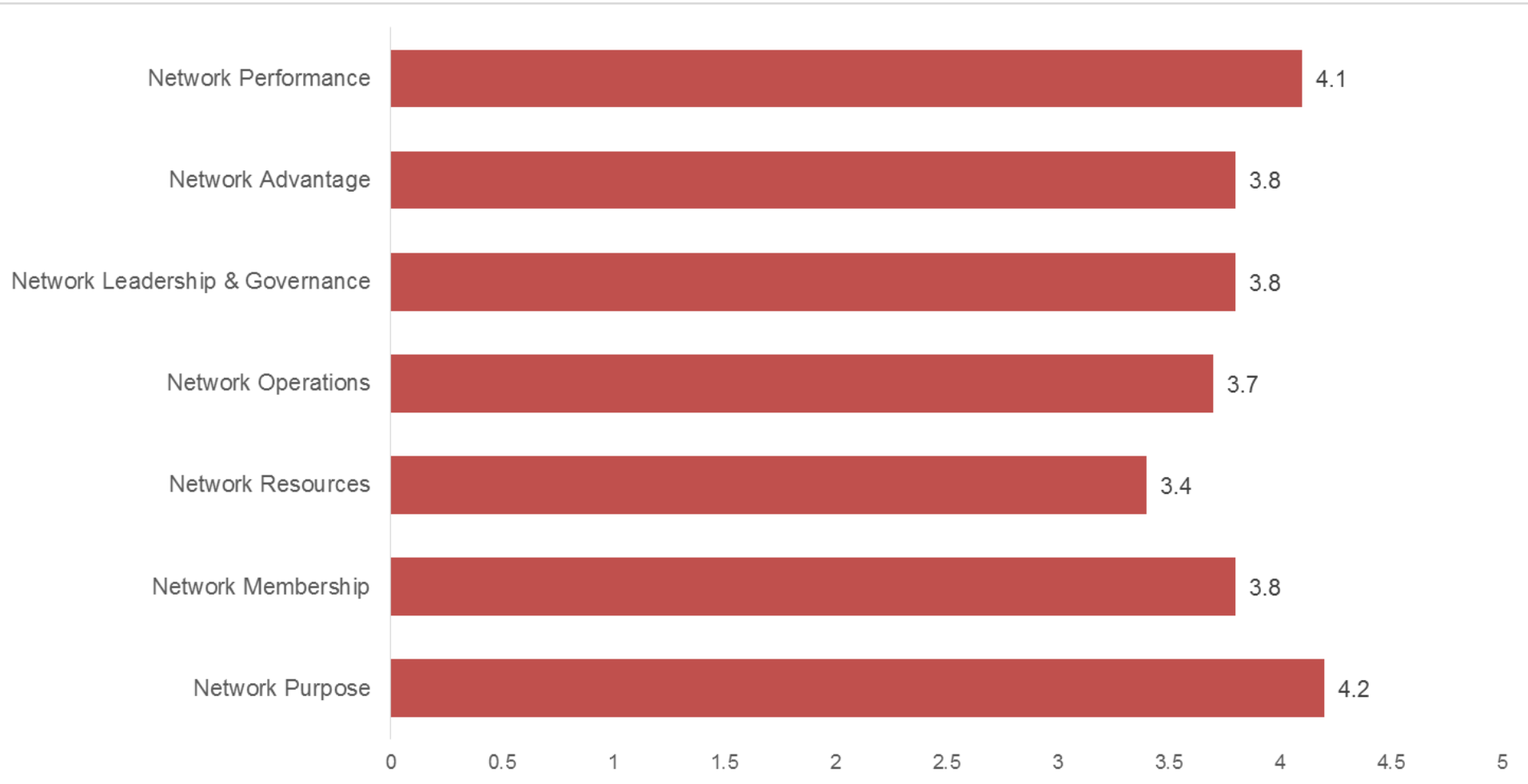
Percentage of respondents who felt the listed services or supports would help them in their work (n=20-22)



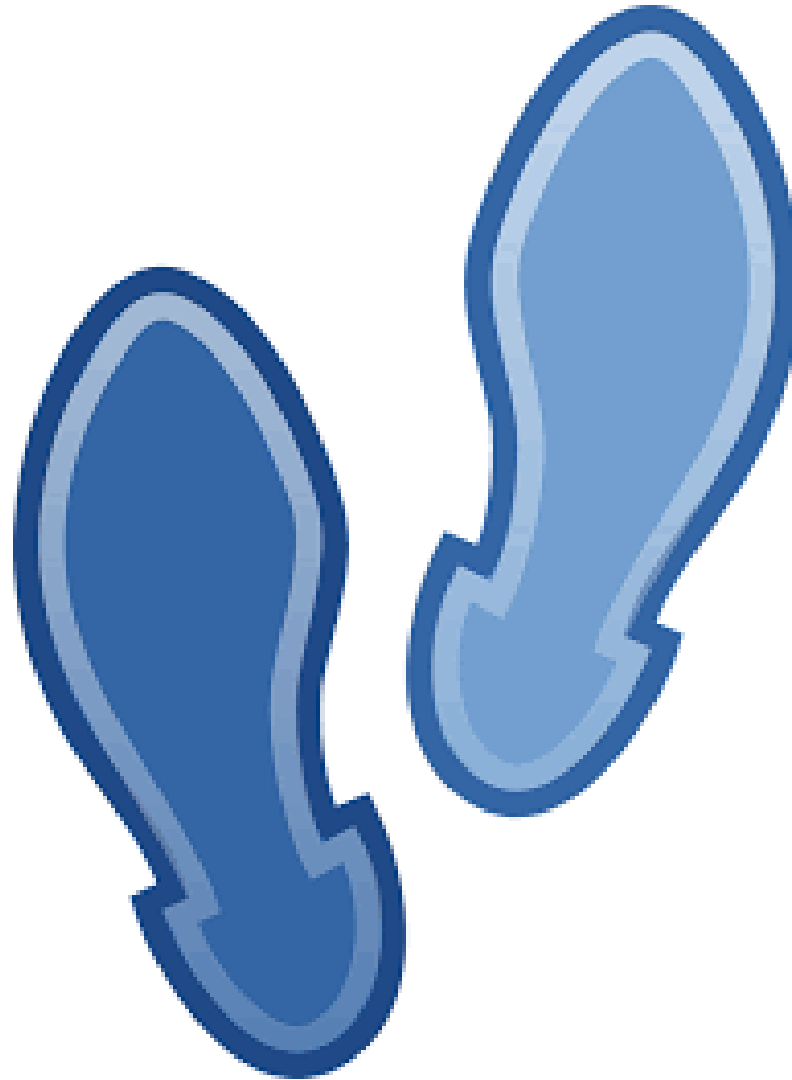
