Indicator 1: Number of people reached through HIV and HCV education sessions focused on risk behaviour reduction	
Description	Total number of people reached through HIV/HCV education sessions/ workshops focused on risk-behaviour reduction.
Significance	HIV education programs have demonstrated to be effective in decreasing risk behaviour and increasing contraceptive use (Kirby et al., 2006).
Data source	CBO administrative data
Possible disaggregation	 Target populations Sessions focused on HIV vs. HCV vs. both Peer education vs. not
Limitations	Participant tracking challenges
