Indicator 9: Number of referrals to HIV/HCV prevention and support services for those at-risk	
Description	Total number of referrals made to HIV andHCV prevention services.
Significance	<ul> <li>Engagement of vulnerable and marginalized populations in the health and social service system aims to reduce transmission of communicable diseases (HRSS, 2013).</li> </ul>
Data source	CBO administrative data
Possible disaggregation	Type of service referrals are made for (e.g. screening/testing for HIV/HCV, syringe services program, post-exposure prophylaxis, mental health and substance use services, etc.)
Limitations	<ul> <li>CBO tracking issues</li> <li>Lack of standardized manner to track referrals</li> <li>Difficulty for CBOs to determine whether client followed through with referral</li> </ul>
