Requirements:

- Are you currently enrolled as a post-secondary student in a relevant discipline?

- Have you worked with Indigenous people and communities?

- Survey data collection and supporting analysis and KTE
- Working with community-based organizations with Indigenous programs
- Working with a team of Peer Research Associates

This is a part-time, contract position of 15 hours/week, available Oct 1, 2022 - March 31st, 2023 (with the possibility of extension). We are looking for someone within British Columbia who is willing and able to work virtually
